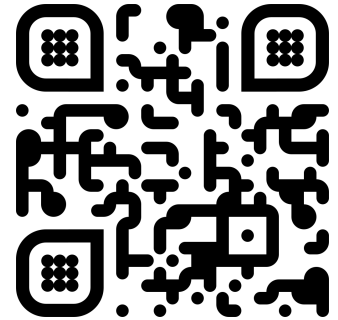




CarHearts.org, a 501(c)3, takes in cars needing work, fixes them & gives them to poor parents (rural & urban), so they can get back to work.
